OBJECTIVES

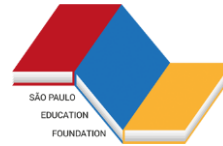
Ensuring High-Quality Teaching: The Foundation will support professional development that improves the quality of teaching and encourages teachers to remain in their assignments for extended periods of time. Specifically, funds support the following:

- Scholarships for teachers to attend quality conferences each year as a way of continuously improving their professional practice.
- Professional development endowments that support research-based teacher training, especially those that align with 21st-century teaching and learning best practices.
- Professional development endowments that support research-based teacher training, especially those that align with 21st-century teaching and learning best practices.

Enhancing Educational Experiences for Students: The Foundation will support programs that improve the quality of educational experiences in eligible schools. Specifically, funds support the following:

- Enhancements in academic programs, fine arts exhibits and performances, athletic programs, scholarship student support, community service programs, and campus improvements.
- Facility renovation and expansion that aligns with current best practices in the field of education and supports college-preparatory programs.
- Scholarship endowments that are based on academic merit and financial need.

Preparing Students to Study Abroad: The Foundation will support programs that best prepare students living in Brazil to study at top schools and universities in the United States and abroad. Also, the Foundation supports post-secondary scholarship programs that prepare students living in Brazil to study at top colleges and universities in the United States and abroad.
