

Supplies

- All supplies should be labeled with the student's first and last name.
- Each student should have enough supplies to last for the entire school year.
- Only students enrolled in the native or advanced level Portuguese as an Additional Language class should buy Portuguese books. Interview/testing for placement into a level of Portuguese will take place during New Student Orientation. These books and dictionaries may be bought locally after placement.
- We recommend that you purchase your books and supplies through Livro Fácil, our school book store. However, students may purchase their books on their own, except those units that provide multiple book choices. Please pay careful attention to the ISBN number to ensure you get the same copy/edition as all other students.
